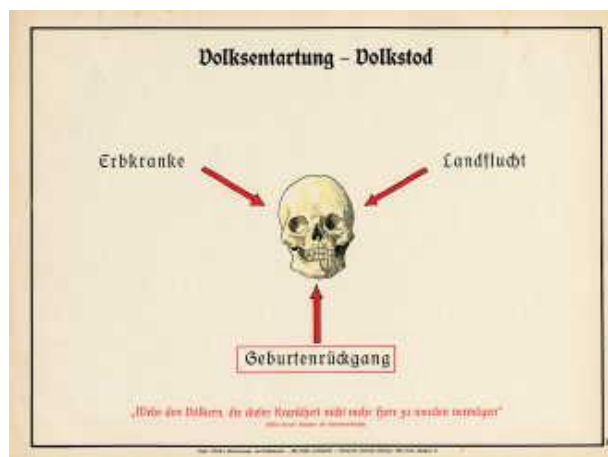


Please join us for a Research Colloquium during which
