Qualified high school students are invited and encouraged to take introductory or intermediate level courses on a space available basis. To qualify for the program you must be in the top 20% of your class with demonstrated academic and extracurricular achievement. Credits earned in this program may be applied toward a degree from Drew University or transferred to another college.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All application materials should be sent to the Director of Continuing Education, Drew University, Madison, NJ 07940. The Admissions Committee will evaluate an application after the following documents have been received by the Office of Continuing Education:

1. The completed application form
2. A non-refundable \$40 application fee
3. An official transcript of your high school record
4. A letter of recommendation from your guidance counselor
5. A letter of recommendation from a high school teacher
6. Personal statement (indicate your reasons for wanting to take a course at Drew)
7. Students interested in intermediate or upper-level courses in the undergraduate curriculum are required to have a campus interview and permission of the course instructor.

DEADLINES: Fall Semester: August 1 Spring Semester: January 1

TUITION AND FEES INFORMATION

Tuition for high school students enrolled in on-campus undergraduate courses is \$500 per credit plus fees as indicated online. No additional discounts apply. Tuition fee does not include the cost of books or any other required course materials.
