Standing Health Orders for International Travel Programs

The Drew University Health Service prepares Standing Health Orders (SHOs) for all Drew-sponsored international initiatives. The SHO contains health information for travelers to a specific country as recommended by the Center for Disease Control.

Program leaders must provide SHOs to all program participants. The decision to follow the recommendations is at the discretion of each program participant, except in cases where a health precaution is required for entry to the country (ie a Yellow Fever Vaccination.) ***Participants are required to sign the SHO to indicate that they have read and received a copy of the recommendations. Signed SHOs should be submitted to the program's sponsoring campus office.***

If you need a SHO generated for your program, contact Drew Health Services at least 8 weeks prior to the start of your program.
