INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FINANCIAL STATEMENT

In order for Drew University to issue an I-20 form, you must show proof that you can fund the University's estimated cost of attendance (listed below) through support from your family and/or your sponsor. It is required that you complete the International Student Financial Statement, indicate the funds that are available to you and provide official bank statements (with amounts listed in U.S. dollars) to support those figures. The University does not offer merit scholarships for international applicants and offers limited need-based assistance.

International students must demonstrate that they can meet the full cost of attendance and that they are academically qualified before being granted admission.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CERTIFICATION OF FINANCES

The purpose of the International Student Certification of Finances is to provide us with complete and accurate information about the funds available to international applicants who want to study at Drew. Strict government regulations, rising educational costs, and economic conditions have made verification of financial resources for international applicants essential. Drew University does not have the option of deciding whether or not to verify the financial resources of their international applicants; financial verification must be made prior to institutional issuance of immigration (Forms I-20 or DS2019).

This document is designed to standardize financial information provided by applicants. United States Consuls scrutinize the statements of financial resources given by non-immigrant visa applicants. The Certification will help such officials make their decisions and expedite visa issuance.
