

## Diversity at Drew

The following table shows the percentages of students enrolled in each of Drew University's three schools: the College of Liberal Arts, the Drew Theological School, and the Caspersen School of Graduate Studies, by gender, and by race/ethnicity, in Fall 2018. Drew follows the reporting [guidelines](#) of the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) in reporting race/ethnicity.

### Enrollment Totals by School
